

Use parent volunteers if you have them!












Image Management: Storing Pictures

Using your Network


- Classes Folders w/ permissions (talk to your tech dept to see what is best for your network)
- Shared drives open to deletion issues

Removable Drive Options

- Multiple Flash drives (be aware of deletion issues, keep a back-up)
- **Burned Disks**

Batch Processing

- Batch rename and resize!
- Be aware of SIZE. The bigger the image the larger the .skp file. Recommend no bigger than 650 pixels wide with 150 resolution.



Requirements:


- Has 4 walls

MISSING:

- Missing ALL Artwork
- Missing sign on the door
- Missing artwork labels

EXTRA:

- Textures on all walls and floors
- Has windows and interesting shape



NEAR Standard

Requirements:


- Has 4 walls
- Has an entrance
- Has sign on the door
- Has artwork

MISSING:

- Missing artwork labels
- No FRAMES on the artwork

EXTRA:

- Paint on all walls and floors
- Has an interesting shape



MEETS Standard

Requirements:

- Has 4 walls
- Has an entrance
- Has sign on the door
- Has all required artwork
- Has artwork labels
- Artwork is all FRAMED

MISSING:

 Artist statements with labels

EXTRA:

 Textures on all walls and floors




EXCEEDS Standard

Requirements:

- Has 4 walls
- Has an entrance
- Has sign on the door
- Has all required artwork
- Has artwork labels with details
- All artwork is framed

EXTRA:

- Textures or colors on all walls and floors
- Interesting shape
- Windows and other details










Intermediate: 3-D Text/ Logo Design




Beginner to Intermediate: 3-D Text Name Art with Applied Textures
