

FRONT VIEW OF THE FACE



Forces are basically the same. Artists sometimes use guide lines to position the eyes and features on a face.

The eyes are in the center. The top and bottom of the rounded ears are between the same parallel lines.

The nose and hairline are equal distance from the center.


