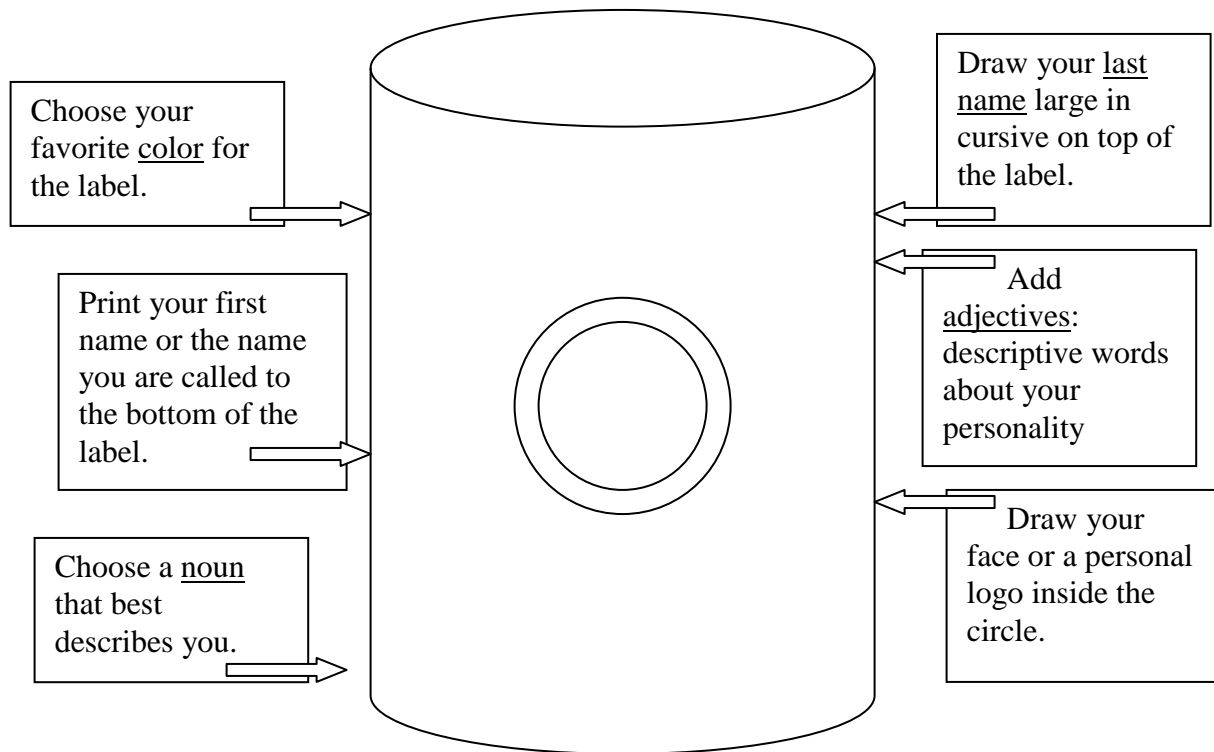


The man... The can... and the plan!
