Five internationally known Latin American musicians take students on an interactive musical tour of the Caribbean as they play the rhythms of Puerto Rico, Cuba, and the Dominican Republic on a variety of musical instruments. You will experience the joyous music of Latin America such as the rumba, bomba, plena, and Dominican meringue through sing-alongs, clapping rhythms, playing instruments, and dancing.

Sumaj Chasquis “Good Messengers” from South America

You will take a chronological musical tour from the pre-Inca time to the post Spanish conquest era. Sumaj Chasquis brings together Bolivian, Indian, and Mestizo musicians to share the enchanting culture and music of the Bolivian Andean highlands. You will learn about the traditions and legends of Bolivia through songs sung in three languages (Aymara, Quechua, and Spanish) and performed on native Bolivian instruments.

Following the all-school performances, NRMS students will rotate through a total of 24 workshops presented by regional and local artists. Each student will rotate through three of these hands-on minds-on workshops by home room.

Arts Day will end with a **Lasermania** Light show performance by Prismatic Magic combining Science, Math, art, and music.
