	<p>Blogger/Blogspot: Free and easy to use. Public. Limitless space. Simple URL. Access it at http://www.blogger.com Example: http://onlineartteacher.blogspot.com</p>
	<p>iWeb: Easy to use. You can edit it offline. Built into most Apple computers. You can add many different types of pages (blog, photo album, about page, widgets etc.) Must buy your own host/domain to share or use your school's FTP hosting. Example: http://web.me.com/hannah79993 (view the lesson plan blog)</p>
	<p>Edublogs: Free and paid options. Safe for most schools. Can create and manage student accounts. Has an easy mode and a more advanced mode. Everything must be approved before it is made public. Simple URL. Access it at http://www.edublogs.org Example: http://ecotbrown.edublogs.org</p>
