Registration Information

• Students age pre-school (minimum 4 ½, please provide proof of age) through sixth grade are invited to enroll in art classes taught by Streamwood High School art educators, and assisted by Streamwood High School students. For five Tuesday mornings, two one hour sessions for grades Pre-K through 6th will be held. (See registration form).

• The course fee is \$75.00 for the first child registered, and \$50.00 for each additional sibling.

Registration for one child – \$75.00
Registration for two children – \$125.00
Registration for three children – \$175.00
Registration for four children – \$225.00

Children must be related, and be registered by the same parent in order for discounted rate to be applied.

- Registration begins May 12, 2009. (Late registration is allowed through the first day of classes, if space is available).
- Cancellations with full refund will be processed until the first day of class.
- Classes meet at Streamwood High School (701 W. Schaumberg Rd. Streamwood, IL 60107) in the art wing via the Visitor's Entrance. Each class meets for five sessions and culminates in an exhibition.

In order to register, please do the following:

- Download the registration form.
- Print and complete registration for all children enrolled.
- Download the release form, allowing the display of student artwork in an online gallery. This gallery space will **not** include pictures of children or the names of children.
- Print and complete the release form, naming all student participants.
- Download the student health information form.
- Print and complete one health information form per child.
